### DISTRICT CODE OF CONDUCT

THE BOARD OF EDUCATION EXPECTS MEMBERS OF THE SCHOOL AND WORKING COMMUNITY TO TREAT OTHERS WITH RESPECT AND COURTESY AND TO CONDUCT THEMSELVES IN A MANNER WORTHY OF THE RESPECT OF OTHERS IN ORDER TO PROMOTE A SAFE AND POSITIVE SCHOOL CLIMATE. THIS INCLUDES RESPECTING THE PROPERTY OF OTHERS, NOT HAVING ANY INVOLVEMENT WITH ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES AND RESOLVING CONFLICT IN A NON-VIOLENT AND RESPONSIBLE MANNER. THE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL CONSIDER THE CONDUCT OF ANY MEMBER OF THE SCHOOL AND WORKING COMMUNITY THAT ADVERSELY AFFECTS SCHOOL CLIMATE TO BE A SERIOUS BREACH OF THE DISTRICT CODE OF CONDUCT WHICH WARRANTS APPROPRIATE FORMS OF INTERVENTION.

2. To ensure that all members of the school and working community are held accountable for their actions.
3. To provide a clear and consistent code of conduct for all members of the school and working community.
